Information for practical exam			
PPE required	Safety boots and high-vis vest or overalls, safety glasses and hearing protection.  Safety helmet or bump cap is recommended but not mandatory.		
Fall-arrest harness	Not supplied by CBIP.  Candidates are required to supply their own fall-arrest harness for the EWP forming the basis of the examination as this is likely to be required during the assessment.		
Check sheets	Not supplied by CBIP.  Candidates are required to record their inspection as they usually would for any client. The recordings made must enable the candidate to provide CBIP with an inspection report and certification (if applicable) for the EWP forming the basis of the examination.		
Tools	Any tools commonly used by the candidate during an EWP assessment. Suggested minimum:  • Small hammer  • Torch  • Camera or phone camera  • Notebook or electronic device to make notes
