

CBIP Yarder Practical Examination – Candidate Guide

Identification

A candidate number will be issued prior to the examination. Only the candidate number may be used on all inspection records, notes, sketches, and reports. Names, employer details, logos, or any identifying information are not permitted.

Practical Examination Overview

The practical assessment involves the inspection of two pre-approved yarder types at agreed site(s). Candidates must demonstrate inspection competence on these yarder types. The inspections are supervised by a CBIP-appointed assessor.

The candidate is responsible for arranging access to suitable machines, as approved by the assessor.

Practical Requirements

Candidates must demonstrate competence in safe inspection planning and execution, identifying defects, deterioration, or unsafe conditions, evaluating equipment condition, and accurately recording inspection findings.

Inspection Records

Inspection reports are required that meet the requirements of the BPG (Note: a company report may or may not fully address all the requirements of the BPG). Records must be clear, complete, and technically accurate, use candidate number only, and exclude all personal and company identifiers. Records that allow identification of the candidate or employer may result in loss of marks or invalidation.
